## Proposals to reform the traffic law

Hej!

The Spanish government is now discussing a reform of the traffic law, what may have a large impact on Spanish riders and visiting motorcyclists from other countries, for example Sweden.

With this letter we want to show our support for the position of the Spanish motorcyclists' organization MMA (Mutua Motera Association, FEMA member) and PMSV (Motera Platform for Road Safety), ANESDOR (National Association of Companies of sector two wheels), PROVIAL (Association of Road Training Teachers) and also hundreds of motorcycle clubs from all over Spain.

Together with the organizations above, we ask the Spanish government to:

- Refrain from an obligation for motorcyclists to wear an airbag vest or similar pieces of PPE
- Not to remove the 20 km/h margin for overtaking
- Legalize the use of communication devices in the helmet or otherwise
- Prohibit applications that allow to warn of police controls for terrorist alerts, kidnappings, drugs.
